Foster Care

You can truly make a life-or-death difference to a homeless pet! Now that kitten season is upon us, we need foster homes for momma cats and kittens, who will stay in their foster homes until the kittens are 8 or 9 weeks of age. We also need fosters willing to take puppies for their two week quarantine period. Foster homes are urgently needed for these first few weeks of life because kittens and puppies, like human babies, are susceptible to germs and really benefit from being in a clean, safe, loving home. Once the babies are old enough, they are returned to our Adoption Center so they can find their forever homes.

Fostering can be a very rewarding experience for the entire family and we will be glad to help you decide what foster situation might be right for your family. We provide you with all the necessary supplies while the pets are in your care. Offering your time, energy, and home to an animal in need allows us to rescue more animals and save more lives.
